**Employment of Technician Apprentices and
Building or Civil Engineering Graduates**

**Particular Specification for Employment of Technician Apprentices and
Building or Civil Engineering Graduates**

- (1) The Contractor shall employ for each capital works contract exceeding \$50M the corresponding minimum number of technician apprentices under a valid contract of apprenticeship, as set out in the following table. The Contractor shall provide to the Architect the names of technician apprentices employed, together with evidence of each technician apprentice's contract of apprenticeship, within three months after the date of commencement of the Contract. Any subsequent changes on the employed technician apprentices must also be reported to the Architect within 1-month time.

(a)	For a contract the contract sum of which exceeds \$50 million but is not more than \$100 million.	- one
(b)	For a contract the contract sum of which exceeds \$100 million but is not more than \$200 million.	- two
(c)	For a contract the contract sum of which exceeds \$200 million.	- three

- (2) The Contractor shall employ for each capital works contract exceeding \$50M the corresponding minimum number of building or civil engineering graduate with an academic qualification gained within the preceding three years, and recognized by an appropriate local or overseas professional institution, such as the Hong Kong Institute of Architects, the Hong Kong Institution of Engineers, the Institution of Civil Engineers, the Institution of Structural Engineers or the Chartered Institute of Building, as set out in the following table. The Contractor shall provide to the Architect the names of the building or civil engineering graduates employed, together with evidence of each graduate's terms or contract of employment and the qualified professional supervising such graduates, within three months after the date of commencement of the Contract. Any subsequent changes on the employed graduates must be reported to the Architect within 1-month time.

(a)	For a contract the contract sum of which exceeds \$50 million but is not more than \$100 million.	- one
(b)	For a contract the contract sum of which exceeds \$100 million.	- two
